In March 2025, GASG will be holding another of our popular series of 1-day meetings aimed at Early Career Researchers. The event will offer newcomers to the field an opportunity to present short talks (of up to 15 minutes, including questions) or display posters in the areas of sensing, analysis and monitoring of gases, volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and particles.

Presenters from academia, industry, government and all interested organisations are welcomed. The event will provide Early Career Researchers with a valuable opportunity to interact directly with their peers and other experienced colleagues in the field. This is also an excellent opportunity for

GASG members and other attendees to hear about the latest cutting-edge research from those active in the area.

We expect the event to commence at ~10:30 with refreshments and registration. Talks will start by 11.00 and finish by 15:30, followed by prize presentations. Three prizes (£100, £50 and £25) will be given for the best presentations. Winners will be selected by GASG committee members at the meeting and are subject to numbers of entries. In addition, the top award winner will be eligible for free attendance at the next GASG meeting.

A plenary lecture will be given by an invited guest and attendees will be able to view posters and discuss them with the presenters during the lunch break. There will be ample opportunities for networking and informal discussions regarding employment prospects in the gas detection field with GASG members from a wide range of organisations. It is also hoped that our generous hosts, Crowcon Detection Instruments Ltd, will provide a short tour of their manufacturing facilities for interested delegates (subject to operational requirements).
